From the Principals Desk...

Middle Team Beach Clean Up:

Last Friday, Rūma Nīkau, Horoeka, Kōwhai and Pōhutukawa took action to do their bit to help the environment. As part of their Inquiry Learning unit 'Tiakina o Tātou Mōana - Care for our Seas', the Middle Team (Nga Tipu) planned to do a 'Beach Clean-up' on areas of beach around Fitzroy and Waiwhakaiho. The type of rubbish that was found and picked up was very interesting but also very disappointing to know that people let this type of rubbish into our waterways.

The students also had a visit from Dr Emily Roberts (Taranaki Regional Council), to talk about the different ways we can take care of the environment. This includes reducing the amount of plastic that could travel to our waterways.

Also as part of design time, Lorella Doherty visited the team and showed how rubbish can harm animals and sea life. She showed the students the artwork that she has created by reusing plastic and rubbish that she collects from beaches. A group of students are now creating a recycled piece of art during design time. Thanks Leonie Negru for organising this. (Please continue to bring in large clear plastic bottles, so we can pass them onto Lorella for her 10 metre whale that she is creating for a Puke Ariki display. No milk bottles though).
