From the Principals Desk...

Kia Ora Koutou, As I am writing this weeks newsletter, I have just received confirmation that the 'Primary Schools Teacher Collective' have voted with a resoundingly 'yes' in favour of the government's proposed settlement. I would like to thank you all for your understanding and support during the past 18 months. We as teachers, didn't take the industrial action lightly, but for the future of our profession and the benefit of our students, it was important. The government, however, didn't address the 'Primary Principals Collective', so their battle continues. We hope that the support continues to help our school leaders.

Our School and Parish saw the need to have one available incase of an emergency in or around our community. The AED is in a locked box. In an emergency when it is required, all you have to do is phone 111, state where you are, and they will give you the code to unlock the box. The simple instructions are on the defibrillator showing how to operate it, as well as voice instructions. The 111 operator will also talk you through the process of the emergency. The main thing is that you know it is there!

School App

Tomorrow, **Friday the 28th June**, you will receive a notification from our school app suppliers, to update our school app. They are moving from 'Schoolapp' to 'SchoolappsNZ'.

Between 10am - 4pm on the above day, an alert notification will be sent to all of your School App users. The notification will be as follows.

"Your School App requires some important updates. Please click here to read more."

On opening this alert they will see a message that explains the update along with a link to begin the update. On clicking the link it will take them to the App Store / Google Play Store to download the SchoolAppsNZ app.

On downloading, the app will open up and display your School's App home screen as per normal with all of their Alert group selections, absentee information etc saved. They are now upgraded to SchoolAppsNZ.
