

Advent Wreath Blessing

The Catholic Parish of New Plymouth extends a warm welcome to the students, families and staff of St John Bosco School to join with the local Anglican and Catholic communities in a combined liturgy to mark the beginning of Advent.

The Advent wreaths of all communities will be blessed during this liturgy. This combined liturgy is being held at the recommendation of The Anglican Roman Catholic Commission in Aotearoa New Zealand who have circulated a recommended liturgy for the occasion.

The liturgy will be celebrated Wednesday 27 November at St Mary's Cathedral - Peace Hall 40 Vivian Street New Plymouth at 7.00pm. Advent begins on Sunday 1st December this year.

Children's Liturgy


Liturgy during Sunday Mass is run by a group of parishioners who take turns to run a 15-20 minute session, catering to children from toddler age to around 12 years during Sunday Masses. The session runs alongside the first part of the Mass during school term times and provides teaching on the readings of the day appropriate to the children's understanding with an activity to follow. Children will be invited to leave for children's liturgy after the opening prayer and return into the church after prayers of the faithful.
