From the Principals Desk...

End of Year Reporting: This year our reporting format has been considerably different from prior years. Reporting on aspects of our curriculum every term has been challenging for staff but at the same time efficient in sharing what we know about you children. End of year reports will be released soon. They too will be different from our traditional reports. We will notify you via email when they are released. The end of year report will contain information about your child's writing It will also contain a and maths personal general comment in relation to the years work. All other areas have been reported on over the past three terms and equate to what our traditional mid and end of reports would have contained (In Fact you've received a whole lot more).

Change of classroom allocation for 2020: Now we have nearly completed our whole school modernisation we will have one final change of classroom organisation. The final change will ensure that collaborative teaching teams are closer together and next door to the teacher they are collaborating with. This will also mean that class names will now stay with the class they will be attached to in 2020 and not change like they have during our developments. 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
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
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
