#### Ash Wednesday

Yesterday we attended Ash Wednesday Mass as a whole school and received the Blessed Ashes in the sign of a cross on our foreheads. This reminds us of the message of Lent which we heard in the Gospel reading *Matthew 6:1-6, 16-18*
