Physical Education Survey: We feel our specialist PE lessons with Ms Lynskey on Tuesdays and Fridays have been popular with, and beneficial to, our students. We are seeking some parent feedback on this. For the past two years we have employed what we would call a PE specialist teacher. The key roles being to

- 1. To ensure our Tamariki receive a minimum of 2 x 30 minute physical activity - skills sessions per week.
- 2. 2. In line with wellbeing provide the opportunity to be active physically during the school learning day.

physical activity, higher levels of engagement in break-time games etc that the kids are organising, these games are attracting larger numbers of kids. We are also noticing higher engagement in class after a mental break and improved attitudes towards learning and physical activity. From a sporting perspective we are also seeing improved ball and movement skills.

We would like to gather some voice from our community. We are hoping that your children are coming home talking about PE, what they are doing, what they have learnt and hopefully you may be seeing some of the skills at home... We will also be surveying, children and staff.


