Playground: We are really pleased to see the children really enjoying our new senior playground. This has been on the to do list for a while. Again this is possible due to the work and generosity of our school families and associations alongside our school Community Group. Thank you! Historically the senior playground has been for children 7 years or older. However, we have looked at the nature of the playground and created the following new guidelines. We have removed the Age limit of 7 from the guidelines and replaced the limit at year 3-6 children only. Year 3 children

however will have the choice of playing on the Senior or Junior Playground based on their personal preference. The Junior playground will be for Year 1-3 children only.
