During the week Teachers have been focusing on their personal goals linked to increasing, immersing and normalising the use of Reo at St John Bosco School. We have initiated our Maori Language Strategy. All staff are working towards the immersion and normalisation of Reo in their daily lives. We will be making resources for ourselves and our children and we look forward to sharing these with you.
