While new cases in the community are always a concern, it is reassuring to see how quickly they have been identified. I am sure we are all grateful for the efforts of our health workers in this regard, and the thousands of people who have been tested. As a community we need to be proactive as we move into the lower alert levels. Please do continue to scan QR codes and monitor closely for illness within your whānau. We will continue to promote safe hygiene practices and ask you to keep children home if they are unwell. School drop off and pick up will be back to normal for us again.

Our focus as always will be to support the learning, safety and wellbeing of our tamariki and we continue to be here to support you too. Please don't hesitate to contact your child's kaiako or myself, if there is something you need assistance with.

Thank you for your support during level 2. As I have said many times it is so easy to manage such situations when you have support from your community.

HERO app: You may have noticed a new


