
Our Lady Help of Christians Feast Day

#### **The Mass**

At Mass we believe that Christ is present in the **priest**.

The priest acts in the person of Christ and presides over the assembly. The priest and other ministers usually come into the church in a procession. One person carries the cross. Often, it is an **altar server**. The cross helps us to remember that we are at Mass because of Jesus' death and Resurrection. Sometimes a person carries in the **Book of the Gospels**. The Book of the Gospels contains all the Gospel readings that are read at Mass throughout the liturgical year. **We honour it because it contains the words of Christ**. During the procession we usually sing a song or hymn. The hymn helps us to unite as the **Body of Christ**.

#### **School and Class Mass**

Attending Mass is important for supporting the RE program in classrooms. We invite and strongly encourage whanau to attend these Masses where possible.






