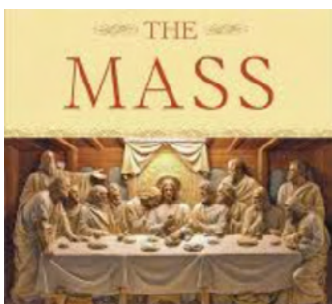
RELIGIOUS EDUCATION AT SJB

More about the Mass..... More about the Mass..... after the Homily, we stand to proclaim our faith in the Creed. The **Creed** express and makes clear what we believe as Catholics. It is usually either the Apostles Creed or the Nicene Creed that is recited. The **Apostles Creed** is based on the teaching of the Apostles. It was written in the 4th century and represents a summary of Christian belief. The **Nicene Creed** is a development of the Apostles' Creed. It was formed as a result of the Council of Nicaea which aimed to solve any misunderstandings that had arisen within the church. The basic content is the same as the Apostles Creed, but is longer and has a more detailed explanation of the key beliefs. To conclude the **Liturgy of the Word** part of Mass we have the **Prayers of the Faithful**. The Prayers of the Faithful help us

enter a prayerful and intercessory frame of mind for the Liturgy of the Eucharist which follows. It's our last response to the Word of God that's just been heard. We've responded in faith through the Creed, now we respond in prayer for others.

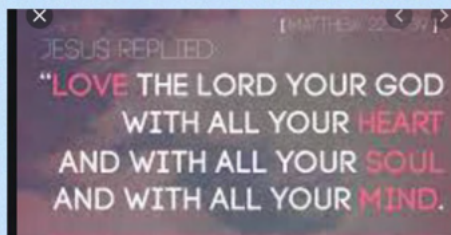

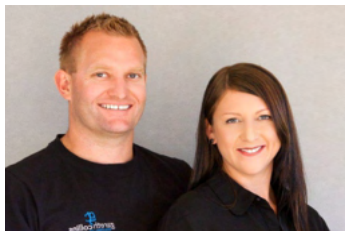
