Ambrose Golf Day Sun 27 March Kia Ora Koutou. I'm breaking trends this week with two newsletters. Hopefully this won't be a new norm... This will be a brief newsletter also.

We are loving the sunshine currently which is allowing us to be outside and continue our mid morning and afternoon swims. The children continue to be amazing.

Our continued focus this week has still been teaching and learning as normal. This week has seen an increase in whanau isolating at home. We have had on average this week 40 children absent. This equates to 15% of our current school population. We currently have 10 confirmed cases of Covid within our school.

We have been really impressed with and grateful for the prompt communication from whanau. There is an incredible sense of keeping everyone safe and following expectations. The staff and I appreciate your efforts, thank you.

I am sure you will all be aware of the new isolation guidelines that come into affect 11:59 Friday 11th March. Isolation periods will be reduced from 10 days to 7. I am still awaiting guidelines around testing times for those isolating and will share these with you once we have them. I will connect with families who have children currently isolating to ensure the process is clear.

I am also expecting that we will follow suit of many other schools and have greater numbers of teachers self isolating. Obviously our first intention is to utilise relief staff to cover those staff isolating. However, I do need you all to be prepared, understand and

support us, as the dynamics of school and classes may change if we are unable to staff classes. We have plans in place for such an event, we really do hope that we will not need to initiate these.

We continue to ask for your support through following our current basic Covid guidelines of...

- Staying away if you are unwell.
- Washing / sanitsing hands when and where required
- Adults on site wearing face masks and social distancing
- Children in Years 4-6 wearing face masks inside.
- Leaving the school premises as soon as you can after school.

Lent has begun

Lent is getting ready for Easter a bit like Advent is getting ready for Christmas. Lent is a time of prayer, fasting and almsgiving. Prayer helps us become closer to God. Fasting is giving up something (good or bad) for the Glory of God. Almsgiving is the giving actions that help us to see God in others. It can be donating money, food, or other items to the poor or needy. Almsgiving helps us experience giving freely.

Liturgical Math: Counting Forty Days
Mathematically speaking, there are 46 days
between Ash Wednesday and Easter Sunday. So
how did we get forty?
It was developed not by means of math but by
theology. Every Sunday is Easter, even during the
Lenten season, for every Sunday is a memorial of
the passion, death, and resurrection of Jesus.
When we subtract the six Sundays of Lent from
the total we end up with forty.



<u>Caritas</u> Caritas helps us focus on Lent and on prayer, fasting and almsgiving. The theme this year is "Called to be Peacemakers: Building Dreams Together". Later this term we will be completing a Caritas Lenten Challenge. More information about this will come out soon. 


