


God is Great God is Love God is Everywhere

Birthday of the venerable Suzanne Aubert (Sister Mary Joseph)

Suzanne Aubert is also known as Meri Hohepa, Mother Aubert, and by many as simply Mother or Grandma. Aubert first



came to New Zealand in 1860 on the boat with Bishop Pompelier. She is the founder of the Sisters of Compassion. Suzanne was well respected and is remembered for her many great works with the sick, orphans, Maori communities and the underprivileged all over New Zealand. She died in 1926. New Zealand's newspapers spread the word and crowds gathered to pay their last respects. Her funeral at the church of St Mary of the Angels is reported to be the largest funeral ever, for a woman in New Zealand. Suzanne Aubert is currently being considered for canonisation by the Pope. She was declared "Venerable" in 2016 which marks an important milestone on the path to canonisation.

We pray that Suzanne will be remembered for the remarkable woman of Christ that she was, and that she will one day be New Zealand's first Saint. May our hearts grow in love for God and in love and

compassion for each other just as Meri Hohepa showed us.
