First Reconciliation Preparation

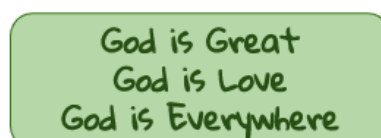

This competition provides an opportunity for students to gain a measure of their own achievements in an external testing situation. ICAS is designed to target students' higher-order thinking and problem solving skills. ICAS assessments are online, this allows greater accessibility for students and faster delivery of results. Every student will receive a certificate and an online result report. Students are eligible for awards including high distinction, distinction, credit, merit and participation certificates. Top performers will be eligible for medals and are invited to attend a special award ceremony.
